Create a Secret Code

In Chapter 5, Mila writes Jigsaw a note with a secret code. Use Mila's code to write a note to the class. Or, create your own code. Write a note to the class and give clues about how to crack the code.

Velocity Machine 2000

Recreate Bigs Maloney's sled. You can build a model out of any material you want (clay, cardboard, Legos, recycled materials, etc).

Favorite Scene

What was your favorite part of the story? Draw a picture, create a diorama, draw a comic strip, or write a paragraph about it.

Imagine a New Sled

Imagine a sled that is better and faster than Velma. Create an advertisement depicting the new, improved sled! Tell about all its different features.

Character Sketch

Pick a character from the book. Draw a picture of him or her based on information from the book. Then add details from your own imagination. Add some descriptive words if you'd like.

Sled Race Poster

Make a poster advertising the Sled Race. Be sure to tell where and when the race will take place. Tell who can enter and if there is an admission cost. Add any other information you can think of!
